Winter Sports begins February 27th and continues through March 20th.

An outline of the program, rules and regulations along with consequences are as follows:

ACTIVITIES:

Downhill or Tele Skiing/Snowboarding:

- Cost without season pass \$114.00 - Payable to Teton High School transportation included
- Cost with season pass \$10.00 Bus travel - Payable to Teton High School
- Cost with season pass w/lessons \$96.00
- Ski Rental: \$18.00 for ½ day payable to Grand Targhee each week or \$72.00 for the four weeks.
- Snowboard Rental: \$21.00 for ½ day payable to Grand Targhee each week or \$84.00 for the four weeks.
- Waiver from Grand Targhee required.

Nordic Track Skiing Grand Targhee:

- Cost without a season pass \$28.00 - Payable to Teton High School transportation included
- Cost with a season pass \$10.00 Bus travel Payable to Teton High School
- Bring your own equipment or see Mr. Gleichman for rental info
- Targhee rental will be \$60.00
- Waiver from Grand Targhee required

Swimming at Green Canyon:

- Cost \$35.00 - Payable to Teton High School
- Transportation Included
- Must have 35 or more students registered to go and maximum of 40

Ice Skating at Kolter Ice Rink in Victor:

- Cost \$35.00 - Payable to Teton High School
- Transportation Included
- Rentals Included
- Must have 36 or more students registered to go and maximum of 40

Bowling at Fat Cats:

- Cost \$30.00 - Payable to Teton High School
- Transportation Included
- Limit to 80 students (45 if we only get one bus)

Gymnastics at TISA:

- Cost \$55.00 - Payable to Teton High School
- Transportation Included
- Waiver required (Pick one up in the office)
- Limited to 30 Students

- Waiver required if under age 16 (Pick one up in the office)
- Limited to 12 Students and minimum of 6
- Learn techniques for improving body tone, body composition, core strength and flexibility, including but not limited to Yoga and Pilates.

Snowmobiling:

- No Fee
- You must have your own licensed machine
- You must have your own transportation
- Waiver Required

Teton Arts:

- Cost \$70.00 - Payable to Teton High School
- Students will be learning ceramic wheel throwing and hand building, drawing, printmaking and painting.
- Cost includes supplies and transportation.
- Waiver required (Pick one up in the office)
- Limited to 24 students

Indoor Soccer:

- Cost \$5.00 (for pizza party on the last day) - Payable to Teton High School
- Instructed by Coach Chewy
- Limited to 20 Students

Digital Photography for Amateurs:

- Cost \$15 - Payable to Teton High School which will pay for a color print of your best photograph,
- Students will be learning how to take and develop photographs using digital cameras and computer development,
- Students do not need to have a digital camera; there will be digital cameras available on-loan.
- Students will learn about exposure, composition, and the basic features of a digital camera,
- Limited to 12 students

- Limited to 12 students

RULES

- Students must stay with the same activity the entire four week period
- Transportation to and from the activity will be provided by the school district. NO driving personal cars, except snowmobiling and horse riding, you must have your own transportation.
- Students must ride the bus to and from the activity and will only be released to parents or guardians
- Students must actively be engaged and participate as instructor dictates
