Teton High School is pleased to be able to provide a program of this caliber for all students. It is important to remember the program must be utilized to maximum potential. If there is **an abuse of students not** taking advantage of the opportunities offered, the program will be in jeopardy.

Winter Sports begins February 24th and continues through March 17th.

An outline of the program, rules and regulations along with consequences are as follows:

ACTIVITIES:

Downhill/Snowboarding:

- Cost without season pass \$122. \$112.00 to Targhee online and \$10 to THS for Bus fee.
- Cost with season pass \$10.00 Bus travel - Payable to Teton High School
- Cost with season pass w/lessons \$104.00. \$94 to Targhee online and \$10 to THS for Bus fee
- Ski Rental: Online with Targhee website or through another service provider of your choice
- Snowboard Rental: Online with Targhee website or through another service provider of your choice
- Waiver from Grand Targhee required.
- If parents want to arrange their own transportation due to Covid, a waiver must be completed through THS.

Ice Skating at Kolter Ice Rink in Victor:

- Cost \$40.00 - Payable to Teton High School
- Transportation Included
- Rentals Included
- First 3 weeks are guaranteed with a possible 4th week doing a different activity. Depends on the ice.
- Must have 20 or more students registered to go and maximum of 30

Gymnastics at TISA:

- Cost \$70.00 - Payable to Teton High School
- Transportation Included
- Waiver required (Pick one up in the office)
- Limited to 20 Students

- Cost \$20.00 - Payable to Teton High School
- Cost includes 8x8 Colored book and pizza on the last day

- Fly tying lessons with local guides, casting lessons and competitions, meetings and lectures with local biologists, outfitters, and guides. We will try to fish the last day, weather permitting.

Students that are not registered for an activity by February 10, 2021 (deadline for registration) will be automatically enrolled into Study Hall and will be expected to attend and attendance will be taken.

RULES

- Students must stay with the same activity the entire four week period
- Transportation to and from the activity will be provided by the school district. NO driving personal cars, except snowmobiling and horse riding, you must have your own transportation. Students must ride the bus to and from the activity and will only be released to parents or guardians
- Students must actively be engaged and participate as instructor dictates

Dear Parents, You can now check your child's lunch account and make payments online - **Winter Sports and other school fees are also now available!**

1. Select the **Meal Time icon found at tsd401.org** (*district webpage , under the Infinite Campus icon on the top left side of the page*).
2. Select Create New Profile on the left side. When creating your profile - *Please make sure to add your email address and check the box to get notifications when your child's balance falls below an amount that you choose (that's for meal accounts only).*

3. Create Username, Password (6 character minimum), enter your info, email, **Select Create Profile.**

You will see a Registration Confirmation screen, **Select Sign In**

4. **Login** to your new Meal Time account (Username, Password), **Select Sign In**
5. **Select:** the Blue Icon: **Meal Account Deposits**
6. **Select: Add a New Student**

To copy & paste that number, click in front of the 401, and drag to the right to select the entire number. This number can also be found on your student's report card.
